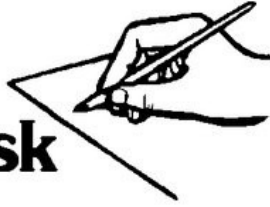


Also on January 29th: EDGE will be starting again! We're really looking forward to it and hope to see all Middle School students there!

This year's Prayer Partners will be conducted a little bit differently than in the past, but the idea is the same! Support a young Christian in their journey and lift them up to the Lord!

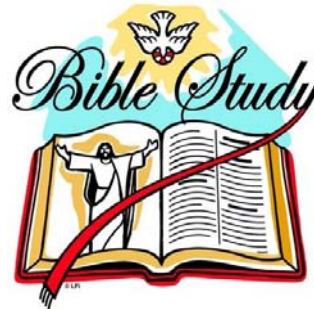
Financial Reporting

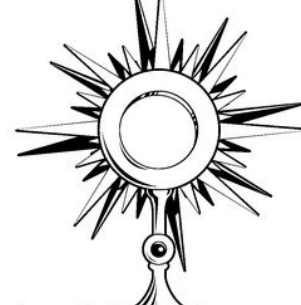

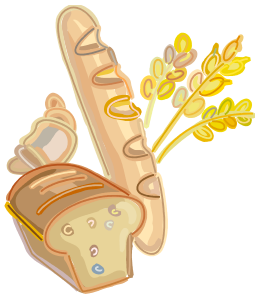

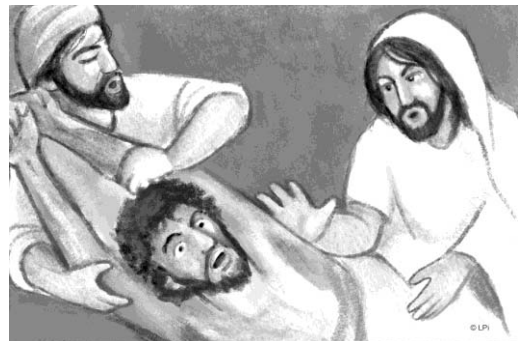
